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THE KWALE COUNTY FINANCE ACT, 2025

No. 4 of 2025

Date of Assent: 8th October, 2025

Date of Commencement: See Section 1

AN ACT of the County Assembly of Kwale to impose fees, charges, levies, taxes and penalties enforceable by the County Government of Kwale, to amend various county legislations related thereof and for matters incidental thereto

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Kwale, as follows—

PART I — PRELIMINARY

Short title and Commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Kwale County Finance Act, 2025 and shall come into operation upon publication in the *Kenya Gazette*.

Interpretation

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

“authorized channel” means the manner in which a person may lawfully effect payment to the County, including but not limited to a person designated by the Executive Committee Member pursuant to Section 157 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012, to collect or receive revenue or any other mode of payment as may be prescribed from time to time;

“Business” means—

- (a) a trade, commerce or manufacture, profession, vocation or occupation;
- (b) any other activity in the nature of trade, commerce or manufacture, profession, vocation or occupation; or
- (c) any activity carried on by a person continuously or regularly, whether or not for gain or profit, and which involves, in part or in whole, the supply of goods or services for consideration;

“County” means the County Government of Kwale;

“County Receiver of Revenue” means the persons designated as such pursuant to section 157 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012;

“County Road” means a road designated as such under national legislation;

“Defunct Local Authorities” means the County Council of Kwale and Kwale Urban Council;

“Executive Committee Member” means the County Executive Member responsible for matters relating to Finance;

“Fees and Charges” means payments imposed by the County Government for permits, licenses or services rendered;

“Fair Location” refers to other towns;

“Far away Location” – Refers to other localities;

“Major Towns” refers to the following towns: Diani, Samburu, Kwale, Kombani, Kinango and Lunga Lunga;

“Non-resident” means a person who does not have a permanent residency in Kwale County

“Official receipt” means a document whether in physical or digital (soft or automatically generated) form issued by the County Government as confirmation of payment;

“Other Towns” refers to the following towns: - Mackinnon, Taru, Msambweni, Kanana, Shimoni, Shimbahills and Lukore;

“Other Urban Areas” refers to the following areas: Tiwi, Vanga, Mwangwei, Mwangulu, Kikoneni, Mkilo and Tiribe;

“Other Localities” refers to all other areas not specified above;

“Prime Location” refers to Municipalities/major towns;

“Penalty” means punitive measures imposed by the County Government on individual or business for failing to comply with provisions of this Act;

“Public officer” means a County Public Officer within the meaning of section 2 of the County Governments Act, 2012;

“Resident” means a person who resides within Kwale County;

“Revenue Collector” means the County Public Officer appointed by the county receiver of revenue pursuant to Section 158 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012; and

“Tax” means a compulsory financial charge or levy imposed by the Government on individuals and businesses to fund public services.

Object and purpose of the Act

3. (1) This Act seeks to prescribe the rates of taxes, fees and charges from properties which include tourism, land, businesses, markets, agricultural produce, outdoor advertisement, health services, vehicle parking, heritage sites, County parks, entertainment, mining and extraction activities.

(2) To enable the County collect its Own Source Revenue.

**PART II— TAXES, GENERAL FEES AND CHARGES PAYABLE
AND RATES APPLICABLE****Imposition, revision of taxes, rates, fees and charges**

4. (1) The fees, charges, rents and taxes provided in the Schedules herein shall be charged for the respective services.

(2) A person who wishes to carry out any of the activities, businesses or make use of county services or property shall pay such applicable taxes, charges or fees.

(3) The County Government shall issue official receipt upon payment of the prescribed fee and thereafter grant the relevant Permit or license to the applicant.

(4) A license, permit or receipt issued shall be visibly displayed at the business premises at all times and or produced on request by an authorized County Public Officer.

(5) The taxes, fees and charges applicable are payable to County Government of Kwale at the commencement of this Act.

(6) Administration of taxes, fees and charges of items not included in the Schedules to this Act shall continue to apply under the existing by-laws of the defunct Kwale County Council and Kwale Urban Council until such by laws are specifically repealed by County legislation and the rates set out therein.

(7) The County Executive Committee Member for Finance may amend any additional fees, tax, license, cess and fees schedules to supplement the current Schedules,

(8) An amendment in sub-section (1) shall be approved by the County Assembly of Kwale.

(9) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this section commits an offence under this Act.

Penalties on outstanding rates for property tax

5. Penalties on outstanding rates for property tax are levied as under—

- (a) penalties shall be levied in respect of property having total outstanding rates at the turn of the calendar year;
- (b) the amount of tax computed shall be increased by penalty calculated at 2 per cent compounded per month;

Penalties on outstanding house and stall rent

6. A surcharge shall be levied for rental default at a cumulative rate of 5 % per month.

Other penalties on outstanding business permits

7. The penalty payable shall be the amount of license increased by a penalty calculated at 3 per cent compounded per month with effect from 1st April of every calendar year.

Waivers and variations

8. The County Executive Committee Member in-charge of Finance may exempt, waive or vary tax, fees or charges payable under this Act in accordance to section 159 of the Public Finance Management Act and prescribed in regulations.

PART III—PAYMENT**Payment through an authorized channel**

9. (1) A payment to the County Government made under this Act shall be paid through an authorized channel which include, direct deposit through the county bank account and electronic channel.

(2) A County Revenue Collector authorized by the County Government to collect revenue shall have an identification card issued by the County Government which shall be worn visibly by such County Revenue Collector.

(3) An official receipt shall be issued for a payment made to the County Government.

(4) A person who makes a payment through an authorized channel shall demand an official receipt for such payment and every payment made through an authorized channel shall be evidenced by an official receipt.

(5) A person shall not receive or collect any money on behalf of the County Government unless he or she has been appointed to do so or has authority as the receiver and collector of County Government Revenue.

(6) A person who contravenes the provisions of this section commits an offence.

PART IV—VALUE ADDED TAX**Imposition of Value Added Tax**

10. The following fees shall attract Value Added Tax (VAT) at the prevailing rates as prescribed by the Kenya Finance Act from time to time but no limited to —

- (a) stall rent;
- (b) slaughter house rent;

- (c) advertisement charges;
- (d) property rent for the development of telecommunication masts;
and
- (e) all commercial rent.

PART V—MISCELLANEOUS

Prescribed Fees, Licences, Rent, Cess etc.

11. (1) Any charges, permit fees, licence fees, rent, cess and such other fees payable to the County Government at the commencement of this Act by any business operating within the county which are not included in any of the Schedules to this Act, shall continue to be chargeable by, and payable to the County Government unless they are repealed by an Act of the County Government or until an Act of the County Government on such charges, permit fees, licence fees, rent, cess and such other fees is enacted.

(2) All business within the jurisdiction of the county shall be required to pay licenses, charges, fees, cess, rent or other prescribed fees unless specifically exempted by any relevant legislation or authority.

(3) All levies, charges, tax, cess, fees and licenses that were payable under the repealed Local Government Act shall continue to be paid and administered under this Act: provided that this sub-section shall also apply to such fees and charges levied by various ministries and departments of the national government in respect of functions devolved to the county governments under part 2 of the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 which fees and charges shall be levied by the County Government on transfer of the devolved functions.

(4) All references to Councils shall include all Local Authorities as were defined under the now repealed Local Government Act, Cap. 265 of the Laws of Kenya.

Repeal

12. The provisions of any other law relating to the rates of charges, licenses fees, cess, and rent or any other fees or charges applicable to the goods, services or activities listed in the Schedules before the commencement of this Act shall cease to apply on coming into effect of this Act.

Regulations

13. The Executive Committee Member may make regulations for the better carrying out of the purposes and provisions of this Act.

1. DEPARTMENT OF TOURISM, TRADE AND ENTERPRISE DEVELOPMENT**(a) Business Licenses and Permits**

Insertion of a new section to the Business Licensing Act, 2017

3. The Business Licensing Act, 2017 is amended by inserting the following new section immediately after section 20—

20B. (1) All business licenses granted under this Act shall be renewed by the 31st day of March in any calendar year.

(2) A business license renewed after 31st March of the year shall attract a late payment penalty at the rate of 3% per month of the license fees outstanding compounded.

20C. (1) The Persons with Disabilities Act 2003 and The Persons with Disabilities (Income Tax Deductions and Exemptions) Order 2010, forms the legal basis for granting of exemptions on Single Business Permit (S.B.P) only for persons with disability. The Executive Committee Member for Finance at the time may give people living with disability tax exemptions upto a maximum of KSh. 10,000 on SBP ONLY (any other charges are excluded from this exemption). However, this applies to waiver of **not more than one business unit** upon successful vetting and approval by the vetting committee appointed by the Executive Committee Member for Finance. Note that **the tax exemption accorded should not be extended to matters related to building plan approval.**

(2) For one to be issued with a Single Business Permit (SBP), they have to pay for the following charges: Application/ Renewal fee, Permit fee, Waste Management Fee, Fire Compliance fee, Branding/ Wall writing/ Advertisement/ Actboards/ Signages (where applicable), Ground/ Plot rent and property land rates (where applicable), Arrears (where applicable).

Amendment of section 21 of the Business Licensing Act, 2017

4. Section 21 of the Business Licensing Act is amended by adding the following new sub section—

21(2) A person who fails to conspicuously exhibit their business license shall be liable to a fine of KSh. 500.
